

FOR THE VALLEY College Scholarship Spring 2024

We here at Community Presbyterian Church believe the students of our valley are the future of our community. We are **FOR** our students. We are thrilled to be able to invest in the future of San Ramon Valley's students by offering a \$3,000 college scholarship to 4 seniors at any of the following high schools: Dougherty Valley High School, California High School, Monte Vista High School and San Ramon Valley High School.

Community Presbyterian Church started a community initiative in January of 2019 called **For the Valley**. We believe that being for others can change the world. We are **FOR** the first responders, local community, healthcare workers, students, teachers, parents, kids, small business and much more.

There are many ways to show someone you are for them. Most often, it is thru a gesture of kindness that the person is not expecting. For example: Taking out the trash every week for a senior neighbor, hearing about a family in need and doing something about it, writing a note to a teacher or coach letting them know how much you appreciate them, bringing first responders donuts with a thank you note, create awareness and care around.....homelessness, equality, environmental care, mental health issues, loneliness, suicide, etc.

THE APPLICATION

Your submission should be titled "How Being FOR Others Can Change The World". Your submission must show how YOU have been FOR others and how doing that can make a difference to another person.

The submission can be in any of the following forms of expression: a song, a photo, a painting, a dance, a drawing, a video, a monologue, an essay or a poem.

THE DETAILS

Whether you are going to a 2 or 4 year college, we want to be a part of your future.

The winning applicant from each high school will receive a letter stating that FOR the Valley will be giving them a \$3,000 scholarship toward their college tuition.



A submission from a high school senior from one of the four above mentioned high schools will be considered for the scholarship.

The submission must be titled "How Being FOR Others Can Change The World" and include the attached form and signed waiver. For the Valley will be using all submissions throughout social media, etc. as part of FOR the Valley's campaign to show how being for others can change the world.

The winning applicant will send in his/her tuition bill so FOR the Valley can pay the school directly in the Fall of 2024. If the winning applicant is choosing to go to a 2 year college, they can choose for the scholarship to pay for tuition to the 2 year college over time or for the scholarship to be held for when they transfer to a 4 year college.

If the student that is awarded the scholarship changes his/her mind and does not attend a 2 or 4 year college program, they will not be awarded the scholarship.

Students that have a parent that works at CPC will not be considered for this scholarship.

The FOR Scholarship team will review all the submissions and contact every applicant no later than May 5, 2024.
